Don Secretary General,

On request of the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) I would like to inform you on the present status of the ratification by Poland of the Energy Charter Treaty (ECT) and the Energy Charter Protocol on Energy Efficiency and Related Environmental Aspects.

The Polish parliamentary procedures concerning the ECT have been concluded in the mid-year of 2000 and the Law containing the necessary consent for the ratification of the Energy Charter Treaty (ECT) and of the Energy Charter Protocol on Energy Efficiency and Related Environmental Aspects has been published in the Official Journal (Monitor Polski) on July 7, 2000 (no. 53. position 636) and entered into force after 14 days from that date.

Authorised by the above mentioned Law and according to the Polish constitutional procedures regarding the ratification of international treaties, the ratification document has been signed by the President of the Republic of Poland on November 24, 2000.

At present, the Polish MFA will proceed to send the ratification document to the Government of the Portuguese Republic, the Depository of this Treaty.

However, when signing the Treaty, Poland made an access to Annex1D which is a list of contracting Parties not allowing an investor to resubmit the same dispute to International Arbitration at the later stage under Article 26. It makes obligatory for Poland to submit to the Secretariat General of ECT the writing statement on arbitration policy and procedures at the same moment the Treaty is deposited. At present this writing statement is being worked out by the Polish Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Economy. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is expected to complete this work very soon and submit it without any further delays.

As far as concerning the ECT Trade Amendment, the Polish MFA wishes to explains that the work on the application required for ratification of this Amendment is proceeding as well, and its ratification is expected to be completed by the end of this year.

I believe this letter explains the present status of the ECT ratification and I would like to assure you that the Polish Mission to the EU is at your disposal for any information about further developments.
